Section Projects

The Section grew to 42 members. The Standing committee grew to 16 committee members from 9 countries. The newly elected officers were Claire Germain (USA), Chair; Dominique Lapierre (Canada), Secretary, and Valérie Alonzo (France), Information Coordinator.

The Section started the practice of holding two Standing Committee meetings, since it is the most important networking and face to face meeting of the year. It also decided for the first time to start a Call for papers for program proposals, in addition to preselecting a few speakers, to encourage a wider participation.

The Section presented a resolution of thanks and gratefulness to Holger Knudsen, Chair, for his vision and leadership of the section. The Standing Committee delivered a certificate of appreciation to Jules Winterton.

The new members of the Standing Committee approved the objectives of the IFLA Law Libraries strategic plan, and agreed to focus on Objective 1 and Action 2 to guide their activities.

Pascal Sanz reminded the group of the importance of translating information into different languages. The two SC meetings were published in English, and translated into French and Spanish, thanks to Dominique Lapierre and Marisol Floren respectively.

The Section's Programs for Puerto Rico were based on the two priorities that emerged as a result of the Göteborg roundtable discussions on "Creating an agenda for international legal information policy," that is, (1) Free access to law, and (2) Authentication and preservation of digital law.

The two programs were on *Promoting global access to law: developing an open access index for official, authenticated legal information* (Radu D. Popa, Chair) - *Political and Constitutional status of Puerto Rico: A Continuing Challenge* (Pedro Padilla-Rosa, Chair). It was attended by 57 participants and appreciated.

A fabulous reception was held at the Supreme Court of Puerto Rico, sponsored by Lexis.

Thus, it is vital that our libraries continue to grow, adapt and transform with new technological innovations to assure that we can meet our goal of making information more accessible."*
