- Workflow Management

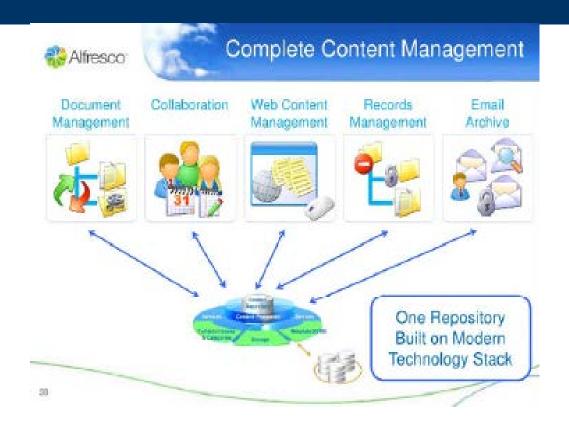

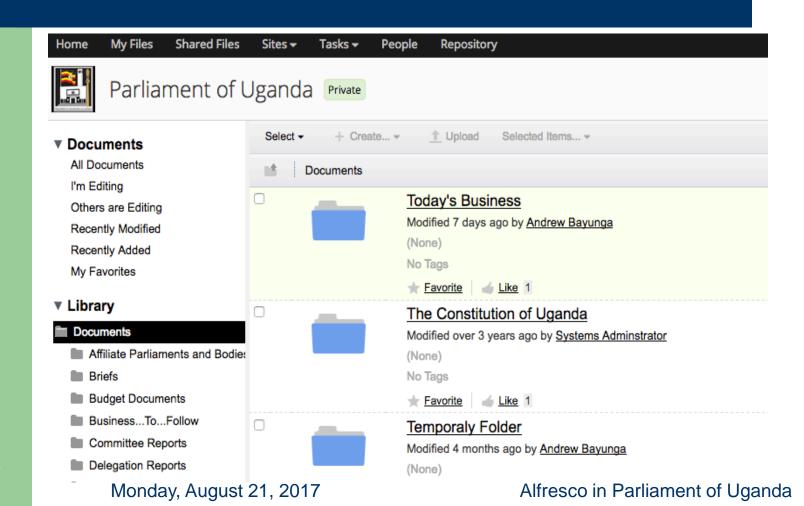

- Users can type keywords / search words and the system will show all documents that match the search in order of relevance.

- Create a Task
- Enter Description
- Enter due date
- Attach Necessary Files
- Send notification



Impact of Alfresco

- Improved management of electronic Parliamentary documents and records
- Access to online information made easier, improving quality of debates
- Drastically reduced expenditure on paper
- Increased communication and discussion through Parliamentary email and intranet amongst the members



Challenge s
