Report of Activities: August 2006 - June 2007

1. MAINTENANCE AND UPDATE OF THE UNIMARC FORMATS

In December 2006, the *UNIMARC/Holdings* format final version was published on IFLANET (http://www.ifla.org/VI/8/projects/UNIMARC-HoldingsFormat.pdf).

The work on the maintenance of the *Bibliographic* and *Authorities* formats continued and the 18th PUC Meeting was held in Lisbon, from 12-14 March 2007. Beyond many other corrections, clarifications and minor changes, most significant updates discussed and agreed include provisions for the accommodation of ISBN 13, Linking ISSN or ISSN-L, and the ISIL - *International Standard Identifier for Libraries and Related Organizations*.

The third edition of *UNIMARC/Bibliographic*, originally projected for publication in July 2007, will be issued in two volumes by the hadipping of 2009, following the publication of the undated Consider Format on the Web.

PERMANENT UNIMARC COMMITTEE (PUC)

Introduction

The **Permanent UNIMARC Committee (PUC)** was formed in 1991, in accordance with resolution No. 5 issued at the Seminar on Bibliographic Records held in Stockholm before the IFLA General Conference, August 1990. The main objective of the PUC is to control the UNIMARC format in accordance with the principles of Universal Bibliographic Control.

The PUC consists of a minimum of 7 and no more than 9 standing members, who are experts in UNIMARC and come from

The UNIMARC Bibliographic format was first created and proposed by IFLA in 1977, with the title *UNIMARC: Universal MARC format*. A second version was published in 1980 followed, in 1983, by the *UNIMARC Handbook*. Finally, in 1987, the *UNIMARC Manual* was published. The current, second edition, is *UNIMARC Manual: bibliographic format*, published in 1994 in a loose-leaf binder to facilitate updates. Five updates were issued in 1996, 1998, 2000, 2002 and 2005.

Strategic goals 2007-2009

GOAL 1 Maintenance and development of UNIMARC in alignment with other MARC formats and new bibliographic standards

- regular functioning of PUC,
- reinforcing liaison with other standard bodies
- implications for UNIMARC of new functional needs of bibliographic information, e.g. FRBR or the management and delivery of digital content



Strategic goals 2007-2009

GOAL 2 Enhance the portability of UNIMARC data to the Web environment and the interoperability with other data standards

- definition of recommended expressions of UNIMARC data in XML
- maintained mappings between UNIMARC and other data schema
- promotion and dissemination of experiences to expose and deploy UNIMARC e.g. with OAI, OpenURL and Web services

GOAL 3 Improve the updating and availability of UNIMARC documentation

- UNIMARC publications' plan
- better support for the PUC activities UNIMARC publications' plan
- private working area on the Web to make the workflow easier
- consolidate and revise the various sources of UNIMARC documention
